5 Scaffolding Strategies

for Improving Quality of Feedback

Scenario

A child is playing with blocks and is frustrated that the tower keeps falling down.



Ask Prompting Questions

"What do you think would happen if we didn't build the tower quite so tall?"

2

Give A Range of Possible Answers

"Do you think we need bigger blocks at the bottom or should we make two smaller towers?"

3

Make Suggestions

"Your block tower keeps falling down. Do you want to try putting all the bigger blocks at the bottom?"

4

Use A Demonstration

As the teacher, make your own block tower to demonstrate how the blocks work best.

5

Provide Physical Support

The teacher can help support the blocks at the bottom or catch the block tower so the child can stabilize it.
